RULES and REGULATIONS



PUSTULKA is a solution for teachers who enjoy writing tests but detest reading and checking them. It saves teachers' time, inspires creativity, develops digital competence, facilitates collaboration, and knowledge sharing. As PUSTULKA tester you shall provide high quality exercises that contain correct answers and no mistakes (e.g. spelling).

When you set up an account with PUSTULKA you agree to adhere to the following rules:

1. You may create exercises using PUSTULKA without any limitations to their number.
2. There are three access levels to exercises:
 - a. private (accessible only to the author of the exercise),
 - b. teachers (accessible to all the teachers who have their accounts in PUSTULKA),
and
 - c. public (accessible to everyone who has a link).
3. The exercises you share with other teachers or exercises you make public shall only be your own work.
4. When you copy other teachers' exercises, they automatically become private in your account. Make sure you do not make other teachers' exercises visible to other teachers or make them public.
5. Do not share any exercises that you do not own copyright in.
6. When you transfer to PUSTULKA any exercises that you do not own copyright in, remember not to share them and to cite the original source of the exercise.
7. When you identify a mistake in other teachers' exercises, you may leave a comment under the exercise to inform its author of a mistake.
